

Project Sheet – Floral Essence Friendly Thoughts Card



Supplies:

Stamps & Bundles: Floral Essence Stamp Set

Ink: Calypso Coral, Crushed Curry, and Garden Green Classic Stampin' Pads

Stampin' Blends:

Stampin' Write Markers:

Card Stock: Calypso Coral, Garden Green, and Whisper White

Designer Series Paper:

Misc. Paper: Medium Whisper White Envelopes

Tools: Stampin' Trimmer, Paper Snips, Big Shot, Scripty 3D Embossing Folder

Embellishments:

Adhesives: Snail Adhesive, Stampin' Dimensionals

Directions:

1. Cut Calypso Coral card stock 5 ¼" x 8 ½", score at 4 ¼" on long side, and fold in half.
2. Calypso Coral card stock 4" x 5 ¼". Run through Big Shot with Scripty Embossing Folder, and adhere to card front using Snail Adhesive.
3. Cut Whisper White card stock 3 ½" x 4 ¾". Stamp large and small flowers onto card stock as shown. TIP: "Stamp off" on scrap paper then onto card stock to get a lighter shade of Calypso Coral.
4. Stamp sentiment in Calypso Coral ink in upper right corner as shown. NOTE: I did not stamp off first here.
5. Stamp flower in Calypso Coral ink on scrap paper and cut out with Paper Snips/small scissors.
6. Stamp flower in Calypso Coral ink on lower left corner of Whisper White envelope.
7. Use Crushed Curry ink to stamp center onto all your stamped flower.
8. Stamp leaves as shown in Garden Green ink.
9. Adhere stamped Whisper White card stock to Garden Green card stock that has been cut to 3 5/8" x 4 7/8".
10. Adhere layers to center of card front as shown using Stampin' Dimensionals.
11. the envelope.
