

Project Sheet – Creepy Halloween Card

I made this card created by Stampin' Up! Demonstrator and friend, Susi Brunk for a demonstrator shoe box swap I participated in.



Supplies:

Stamps & Bundles: Spooktacular Bash Bundle (includes Spooktacular Bash Stamp Set & Ornate Frames Dies)

Ink: Tuxedo Black Momento Ink Pad

Stampin' Blends:

Stampin' Write Markers: Pumpkin Pie, Real Red, Smoky Slate

Card Stock: Basic Black, Basic Gray, Very Vanilla

Designer Series Paper: Monster Bash DSP

Misc. Paper: Very Vanilla Note Cards & Envelopes

Tools: Stampin' Trimmer, Ornate FramesDies, Stylish Scroll Embossing Folder

Embellishments: Basic Black 3/8" Scalloped Edge Ribbon

Adhesives: Snail Adhesive, Stampin' Dimensionals, Glue Dots

Directions:

1. Fold Very Vanilla Note Card in half.
2. Cut Basic Gray card stock 3" x 4 ½". Emboss with Stylish Scroll Embossing Folder.
3. Cut Monster Bash DSP 3" x 1 ½" and adhere to bottom of embossed card stock.
4. Wrap 4" piece of Black Scalloped Edge Ribbon around layers covering top edge of DSP slightly. Adhere ends to back side.
5. Adhere layers to card front using Snail Adhesive.
6. Stamp vampire in frame image in black ink on Very Vanilla card stock and color with Stampin' Write Markers. Cut out with coordinating die from Ornate Frames Dies.
7. Cut Basic Black card stock using filigree die. Layer vampire in frame onto this piece using Stampin' Dimensionals.
8. Adhere layers to card front as shown using Snail Adhesive.
9. Stamp sentiment in Tuxedo Black Ink on Very Vanilla card stock and cut out with small label die from Ornate Frames Dies. Adhere to card front as shown using Stampin' Dimensionals.
