

Project Sheet – Eclectic Garden Bird Card

Supplies:

Stamps & Bundles: Eclectic Garden Stamp Set

Ink: Tuxedo Black Momento Ink Pad

Stampin' Blends: Cajun Craze, Daffodil Delight, Mossy Meadow, Night of Navy, Soft Suede

Stampin' Write Markers:

Card Stock: Basic White, Cajun Craze, Mossy Meadow

Designer Series Paper:

Misc. Paper: Basic White Medium Envelope

Tools: Paper Trimmer, Bone Folder, Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, Stitched Greenery Die

Embellishments:

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal Adhesive or Multipurpose Liquid Glue, Stampin' Dimensionals or Mini Stampin' Dimensionals, Mini Glue Dots

Directions:

1. Cut Cajun Craze card stock 5 ½" x 8 ½", score at 4 ¼" on long side, fold in half.
2. Cut Basic White card stock 5 ¼" x 4". Adhere to inside of card. TIP: If you want to include a stamped sentiment or image on the inside of your card, stamp it before adhering card stock.
3. Cut Mossy Meadow card stock 5 ¼" x 4". Run through Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine with Stitched Greenery Die. Adhere to card front.
4. Cut Mossy Meadow card stock 4 3/8" x 3 1/8".
5. Cut Basic White card stock 4 ¼" x 3". Adhere to Mossy Meadow card stock from step 4.
6. Adhere layers to center of card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Cut Basic White card stock 4" x 2 ¾". Stamp bird in branch image in upper left corner and sentiment in lower right corner in Black Momento Ink.
8. Color branch and leaves with Stampin' Blends in Mossy Meadow and Soft Suede.
9. Color bird with Stampin' Blends in Cajun Craze, Daffodil Delight, Night of Navy, and Soft Suede (beak).
10. To create "splatters" on the stamped and colored card stock, open the paintbrush tip of your Dark Soft Suede Stampin' Blends marker, hold it a few inches over the card stock, and hit the plastic above the ink tip with another closed Stampin' Blends. Repeat as many times as you like over different parts of the card stock. TIP: Work on a piece of scrap paper and remove the card base and other items out of the way before "splattering" ink.
11. Adhere stamped and colored card stock to center of card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
12. Stamp envelope as desired.
